

## Citizens Advice Hampshire's Home and Well Project

## **Headlines April 2020 - March 2021**

It is a **partnership** of **Citizens Advice Hampshire**, CCG, Energy, Water... **Aims** to help vulnerable people and reduce hospital re-admissions

- Delivered by Citizens Advice Home and Well Advisers countywide
- Engages with local **hospitals** Petersfield, IoW, Gosport...
- The project has supported 768 vulnerable people in Hampshire & IoW
- > 526 of those were signed up to the Priority Services Register
- ▶ 476 were helped with Energy related tools a CA wrap-around service
- > Also supports people with income maximisation/debt advice

## **Close Encounters Project**

- > 3 Year National Lottery Community Funded partnership project
- ➢ Gosport Voluntary Action (GVA) & Age UK Portsmouth, NHS South Central Ambulance Service (SCAS), University of Portsmouth (evaluation)
- ➤ Tacking Social Isolation (55+) developed a referral system for <u>SCAS call</u> handlers & clinicians re frequent callers (often due to loneliness)
- 20% of Hampshire's 243,000 65+ residents are 'mildly lonely' and another
   10% are 'intensely lonely'. It has a negative affect on health & wellbeing
- > Close Encounters also enables older people to access welfare benefits
- ➤ Helped **1071** people in Gosport/Portsmouth <u>since</u> January 2019
- During COVID-19 in 2020 = 394 Activity Packs and 980 Food Parcels

## **GVA's Community Compass Project**

- During COVID-19 a remote, **listening & signposting** service
- Developed from GVA's Surgery Signposting Project (past 5 years)
- Delivered by a small team of friendly, trained & dedicated volunteers, p/t Project Co-ordinator & p/t Project Manager
- Top key social issues presenting:- Depression/Anxiety, Bereavement, Social Isolation, Carers Support, Socialising and Dementia
- ➤ Helped **230** people last year; funding ends June 2021
- A local **volunteer delivered** project that <u>changes people's quality of life</u>, enabling them to live <u>independent happier</u>, <u>healthier lives</u> **reducing demand on GP's time** & **saving the NHS money**
