



Volunteer Awards 2020-2022

Criteria for Nomination



Nominations can be made for:

1) **Volunteers with community organisations**

To qualify, nominees: -

- ✓ Must volunteer for an organisation that provides a service in Gosport.
- ✓ Volunteer for an organisation that does not have their own formal awards scheme.

2) **Individual volunteers**

To qualify, nominees: -

- ✓ Must volunteer in Gosport but not be connected to an organisation
- ✓ Nominations must be accompanied by **two references**

3) **Young People (aged 16-25 years)**

To qualify, nominees: -

- ✓ Must have volunteered for a minimum of 25 hours, for an organisation that provides a service in Gosport.
- ✓ Should not be eligible for an award for their voluntary work from any other organisation (e.g., Duke of Edinburgh).

4) **Employee volunteers**

To qualify, nominees: -

- ✓ Must have volunteered on a short-term task/project agreed by their employer and a voluntary organisation in Gosport.
- ✓ **Or**, have been seconded to a Gosport voluntary organisation on a short or long-term basis.
- ✓ **Or**, have offered a long-term commitment to a Gosport voluntary organisation, after having been introduced to volunteering by their employer.

Certificates are awarded for: 1 year/100 hours', 5 years', 10 years' and 20 (Lifetime) years' Service, Employee Volunteers and Young People.

To make a nomination:

1. Read the criteria carefully
2. Complete the nomination forms online www.gva.org.uk/volunteer-awards OR complete the paper forms
