### Pre-COVID and COVID Response



- Delivering creative workshops to 1700 Islanders each month – predominantly older people
- Working in community venues, care homes and supported accommodation schemes Islandwide
- Small Pop-Up gallery space on Newport High Street
- Working with Freelance artists and a small staff team to deliver our work, supported by 70 volunteers.







- Switch to zoom delivery for some projects and You Tube for others
- Moved Community Connector to community response and welfare calls – supported by some volunteers
- Maintaining some income for Freelance workforce
- Postal packs, Creative Chronicle magazine, pen pal project
- Ran face to face and outdoors when possible
