Community First's Wellbeing Programme

- Working with clients referred by the <u>Drug and Alcohol</u> team at QA, the team is using a <u>personalised approach</u> to support clients <u>maintain</u> their <u>independence and stay safe</u>. Ensuring <u>awareness of community-based support</u> structures and services they might otherwise be unaware of, that help to address and <u>support</u> their <u>wellbeing</u> in a more holistic manner
- We are aiming to <u>reduce social isolation</u> and are including a <u>programme of activities</u>, outings and volunteering opportunities







Community First's Wellbeing Programme...

- Digital Champions
 - We are working with <u>Volunteer Digital Champions</u> to enable clients to have better access to health services and wellbeing support, taking advantage of digital gateways
 - Our volunteers can <u>support individuals or small groups</u> and we are hoping to start a monthly Drop-in starting in March 2023
 - We are always on the look out for <u>more volunteers</u>, full training is provided, but also if you have clients in South East Hampshire who need of some digital support please contact us
 - We do also have some resources as well as <u>access to data packages</u>, for clients
 - Wellbeing services...



Gosport Voluntary Action (GVA)

- Core20Plus5 (Fareham and Gosport) Local Integrated Care Board (ICB) 1 Year Pilot Project
 - Tackling health inequalities supported by the Primary Care Networks across Gosport and Fareham
 - Two core patient cohorts <u>Severe Mental Illness</u> (under 30s) & <u>Hypertension</u> Case Finding (over 30s)
 - o <u>Fareham area</u> interested in identifying/supporting any homeless patients from the above two cohorts
 - Gosport continuity of maternity services/care, including for minority communities
 - Linked to 2022's local <u>Population Health Management</u> work in Gosport
 - 21 hr a week <u>Connector Coordinator</u> has been recruited and starts 1 March 2023
 - Will be recruiting and seeking/supporting patient <u>Volunteer Connector Champions</u> across the areas
 - Enabling those with lived experience, to identify any barriers, <u>suggest potential solutions</u> –
 to influence and hopefully improve, the development of and access to, <u>local healthcare services</u>
 - <u>Learning</u> will be <u>shared</u>
- ➤ Welcome to GVA's <u>Ukraine Coordinator</u> (Larysa Minihane) 10 hrs per week, identifying/engaging with Ukrainians living in <u>Gosport</u> (new **Drop-in** at **GVA** coming soon!) links with government, health & wellbeing or community organisations, a wide range of <u>support</u> and help with educational or any other issues eg Ukrainian student bullying...

Affordable warmth services

We target our services at households most at risk from living in a cold home:

- **Low income** incl. those on means tested benefits
- **III health** long term chronic physical and mental health conditions
- **Age** those over 65; families with children under 5

We support and advise local residents:

- Over the phone
- By email or letter
- At home visits*

Advice areas

- Accessing funding for home energy upgrades e.g. broken heating replacements, heating improvements, insulation and draught proofing*
- Temporary heating for households whose heating has failed*
- Tackling condensation and mould
- Vulnerable consumer support e.g. priority services register, warm home discount
- Onward referrals/signposting for income maximization (benefit and debt advice), crisis support (food banks & utility vouchers) and, home safety & fire security assistance
