- ➤ GVA's National Institute for Health & Care Research (NIHR) funded research is looking at the Impact of Health Inequalities on Anti-Social Behaviour in young people is underway.

 Draft questionnaires have gone out for comment
- Sosport's new Health Stakeholder Network met for the first time last week, it was very successful and is looking at delivering a strategic cross-department message on health
- ➤ **Ukrainian Hub** very successful community event organised by Bridge to Unity in Havant for Gosport and Fareham Ukraine Families on Ukrainian National Day. Thank you to all involved and to Hampshire County Council for the funding
- Angela Gould (GVA's Health Project Manager) now attends most health-related meetings

Hampshire ICB Update



Fareham Update

- Met with the local GP Clinical Leads
- We have £5k fund to spend on engagement locally to work with the population re what health initiatives would be beneficial?
- Have put in a bid for £100k for COMF funding, which is for Vaccine inequalities money, with the
 view to support access to vaccines and wider health across Hampshire, but Fareham will be a
 focus area for part of this funding (along with Andover, Basingstoke, Havant and Gosport). This
 is being worked up with Hampshire County Council



Gosport Update

- Gosport Health Network held its inaugural meeting last Monday. This new network is a
 merging between the former Health & Wellbeing Partnership (GBC led) with Gosport Primary
 Care Network's Stakeholder Board. The Network received a presentation on the health of
 Gosport and will be shortly agreeing mutual priorities to improve health and tackle health
 deprivation across the area
- New Neighbourhood Model of Care the ICB is working with a range of other health services,
 Gosport PCN, the LA, SCAS and Portsmouth Hospitals Trust. The purpose of this collaboration
 is to identify and provide new ways of working to manage demand and ensure that services are
 used for maximum benefit. So far, two clear work streams are emerging and these will be
 considered further next week
- Willow Incredible Garden this project continues to grow and all of our volunteers have been actively harvesting all of the produce they have grown. Plans are underway to develop the next phase of the Garden which will see us developing an outdoor learning space and start work on the Heart of the Surgery Garden which will provide an area for enjoying some time out in a contemplative, sensory space. ICB Update

The ICB continues to undergo a restructure, which has led to a change in staff locally.

- The team will continue to support projects in neighbourhoods
- The neighbourhoods that we are working in is increasing with the reduction in team size
- Cam Todd has moved into a wider system population health role
- Focus will be on areas of highest deprivation (so Havant, Fareham and Gosport remain a priority)

Bobby Scheme

- Delivered by 5 fitters (4 in Hampshire, 1 on IoW)
- The service is available to anyone who is vulnerable due to:
 - Circumstance e.g. domestic abuse, hate crime, dementia, serious health condition (18+)
 - Physical or Mental disability (18+)
 - Victim or repeat victim of crime (18+)
 - Age (over 65)













What does a Safety and Security check involve?

- Practical security and safety advice
 - Fit security equipment
- Fire safety check
 - Fit smoke alarms
- Gas safety advice
 - Fit Carbon Monoxide detectors
- Advice on crime prevention
- The service is free













What can we provide?

Free of charge we can fit a range of security measures based on the findings of the survey. Items such as

- Door chains
- Spy holes
- Extra locks and bolts
- Window alarms
- New locks



















Keys safes and Ring Doorbells

- Supra C500 Key Safe
- Police accredited(Secured by design) key safe
- Easy to use and robust
- £75 for the supply and fitting
- Guaranteed for 5 year
- Ring 2nd generation Video Doorbell
- Police accredited(Secured by design)
- £90 for supply and fit
- Guaranteed for 1 year















What does a Cyber Bobby visit involve?



- Delivered by 3 volunteers in Hampshire
- How to create strong passwords and keep them safe
- Making sure your email account is secure
- How to check your privacy settings
- How to update your devices and turn on automatic updates
- Advice on backing up your devices
- How to recognise scam emails and text messages
- Actions to stay safe online while browsing and shopping
- How to report issues
- Signposting to other advice
- The service is free













Impact

- Bobby Scheme and Cyber Bobby Scheme
 - Crime prevention
 - Practical support for victims of crime
 - Reassurance for the elderly and vulnerable











Impact of the Bobby Scheme

Situation

A couple, victims of burglary in Gosport
Wife very upset, feeling very insecure



What we did

Full safe and secure check

Fitted new locks and window alarms

Left advice leaflets



"if wasn't for the work you guys done to help, my wife would have had us move house!. You have allowed her the freedom to feel secure in our home. Thank you" "very needed and deserving Trust"











Impact of the Bobby Scheme



Situation

Mother and daughter both victims of domestic abuse. Perpetrator threated to burn the house



What we did

Fitted new locks and window and door alarms. Blanked off the letterbox and fitted external letter box



Impact

Perpetrator tried to set fire to the front door during the night. Window and door alarms woke mother and daughter who were able to exit to safety through the back door
